

2009-10 CSRDE Peer Report

September 2010

Highlights:

- ❖ Both CSU retention and graduation rates increased for the FA03 cohort as compared to the FA02 cohort.
- ❖ Compared to our peers, CSU ranks higher on the six-year graduation rate than the one-year retention rate.

Summary

Each year CSU participates as a member in the Consortium for Student Retention Data Exchange (CSRDE) that is managed by the University of Oklahoma. It is comprised of both public and private institutions at the 4-year and 2-year level. Currently, there are over 400 member institutions. As part of our membership, we provide retention data on our first-time, full-time cohorts that is then provided back to us along with the data from our self-selected peer group. The current report summarizes the 2009-10 data. Our self-selected peer group was identified based on their Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) offerings and includes the following institutions:

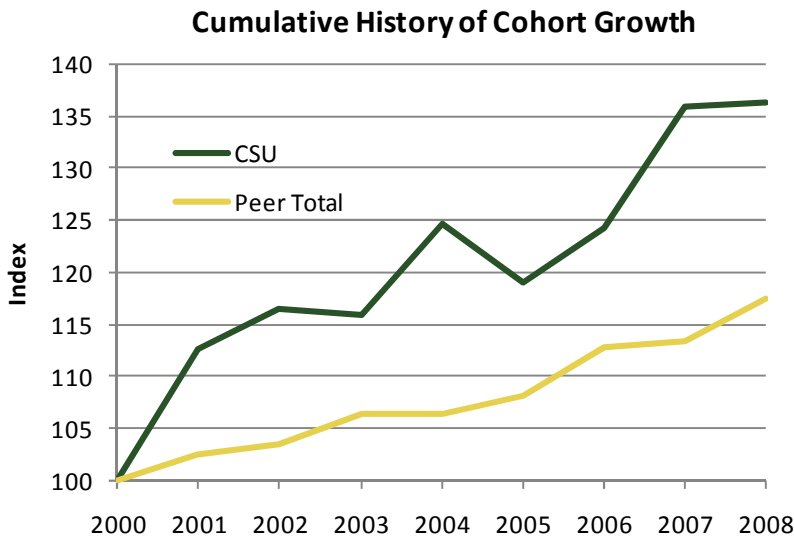

Enrollment

Cohort sizes have increased steadily across institutions from 2000-2008. At CSU, the cohort size has increased by more than 35% during this time

while the peer group increased by 17%. Chart 1 displays the growth in terms of headcount. The Colorado School of Mines had the smallest fall 2008 cohort (848) and Texas A & M had the largest of the peer group (7,465). CSU ranked 11th with a fall 2008 cohort size of 4,404.

Demographics

All of the peer institutions selected are public universities with high or very high research activity (Carnegie classification). All except the Colorado School of Mines (CSM) are considered large institutions. Although different in this respect, CSM is included in the analysis because of their STEM offerings and their location.

Seven of the eighteen peer institutions are described as primarily nonresidential (as is CSU). This is important as nonresidential institutions face unique challenges with retention.

CSU has an average ACT composite score lower than that of any of the 11 peer institutions that provided average scores.

CSU ranks 13th for fall 2008 average GPA (2.79) with 16% of students earning a GPA below 2.0.

The cohorts are roughly split 50/50 by gender except at CSM and UC-Davis where females account for 30% and 58% respectively.

First-Year Retention

Table 1 displays the total retention rate trends by institution. CSU ranks 16th among our peers in total first-year retention for the fall 2008 cohort.

Tables 2 and 3 display one-year retention rates by gender sorted in descending order by the fall 2008 retention rate. Most of our peers retain female students at a higher rate than males. However, the opposite is true on our campus.

Six-Year Graduation

The FA02 cohort had a six-year graduation rate of 62.9%; 1.8 percentage points lower than the previous cohort (FA01). The FA03 cohort regained more than half of that loss with a 63.9% graduation rate. Table 9 displays six-year total graduation rates by institution sorted in descending order by the fall 2008 graduation rate.
