Full-Time/Part-Time Enrollment

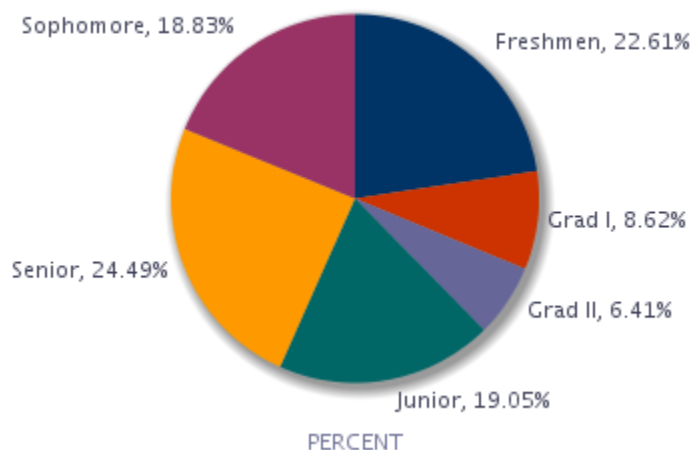

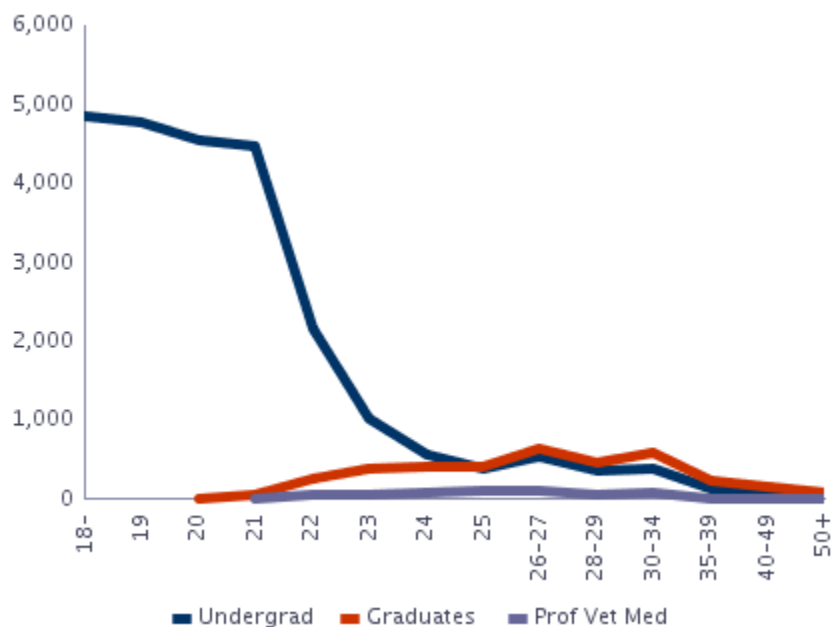
