





Fall 2019 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Gender - Percent of Students



Fall 2019 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Minority Status - Percent of Students



Fall 2019 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and International Status - Percent of Students



Fall 2019 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Registration Type - Percent of Students



Fall 2019 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Residency - Percent of Students



Fall 2019 Graduate Enrollment by College and Residency - Percent of Students






Fall 2019 CCHE Index Distribution



Fall 2011 to Fall 2019 Percent Change in New Freshman by Application College








Fall Term New Freshman First-Year CSU Grade Point Average - Fall 2018 Entering Freshmen (* including summer starts)

First-Year CSU Grade Point Average and CDHE Index




First-Year CSU GPA Distribution - Number of Students








Fall 2019 Undergraduate Students by Credit Load






Degrees Awarded by Degree Category and STEM Status - Percent of Students


Degrees Awarded by Degree Category and Gender - Percent of Students



Degrees Awarded by Degree Category and Minority Status - Percent of Students



History of New Freshman Retention and Graduation Rates (includes summer starts)




History of Transfer Students 2nd-Fall Persistence and Graduation Rates
















Transfer 2nd-Fall Persistent by Residency - Comparison with Total








Transfer Students 4.5-Year Graduation by Residency - Comparison with Total








