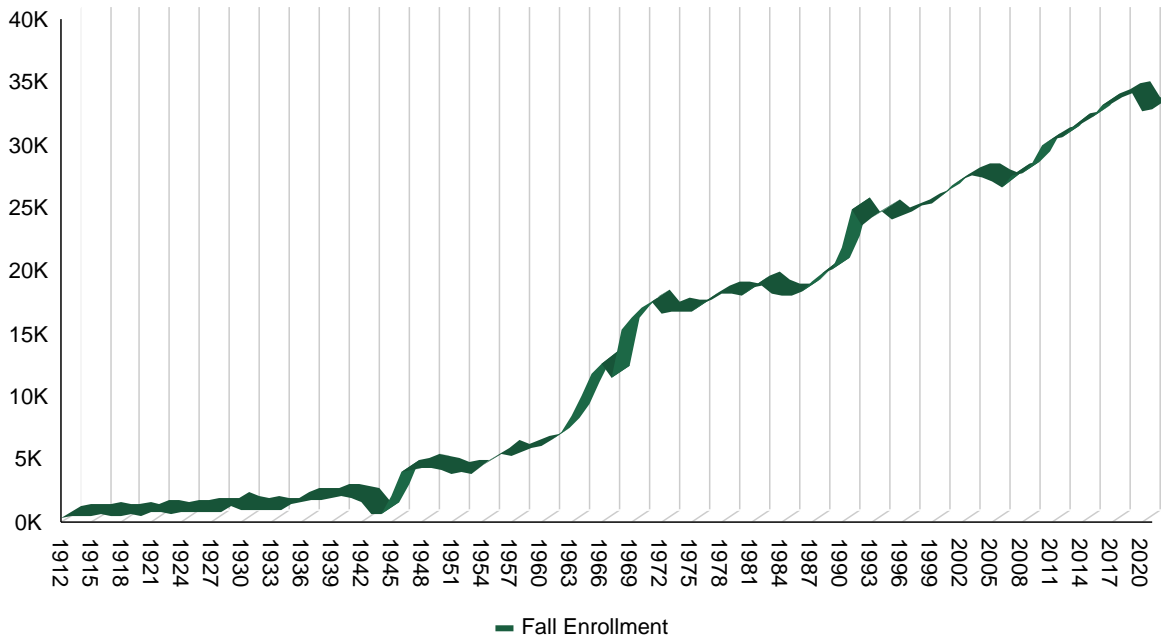

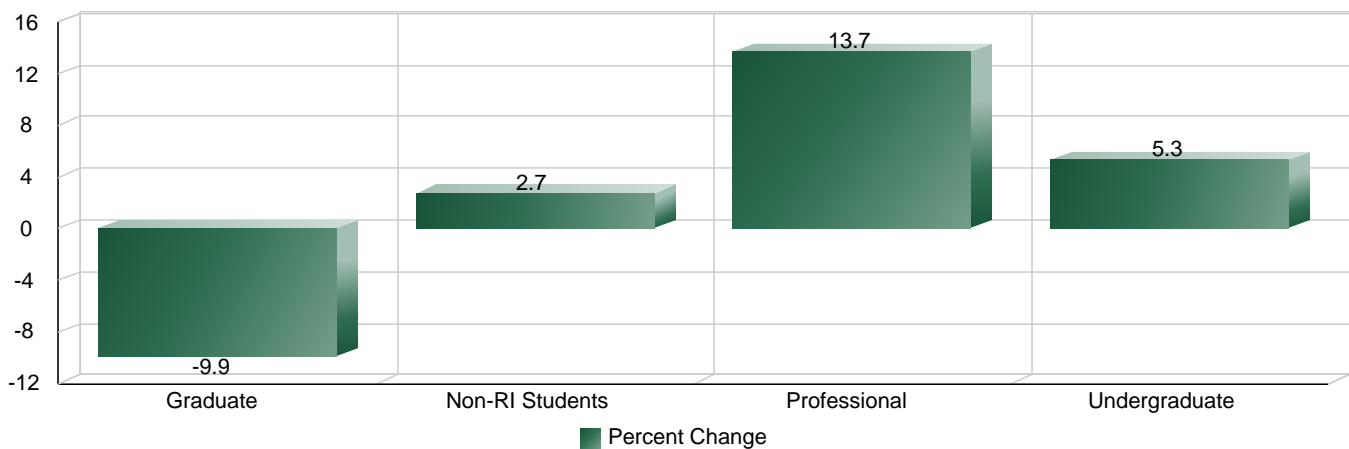

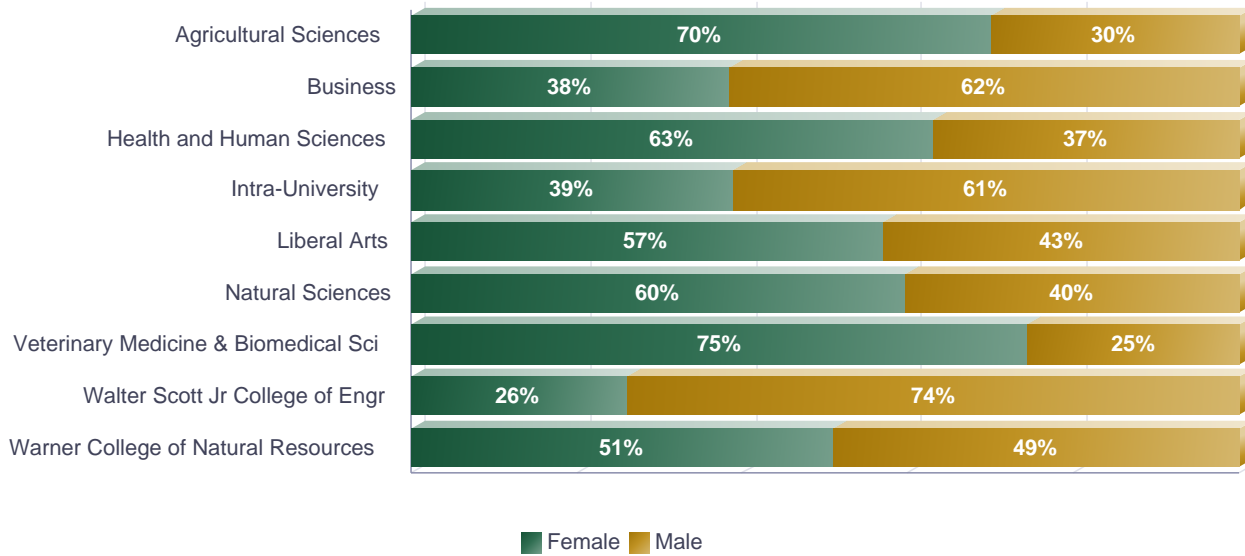

Fall 2021 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Gender - Percent of Students

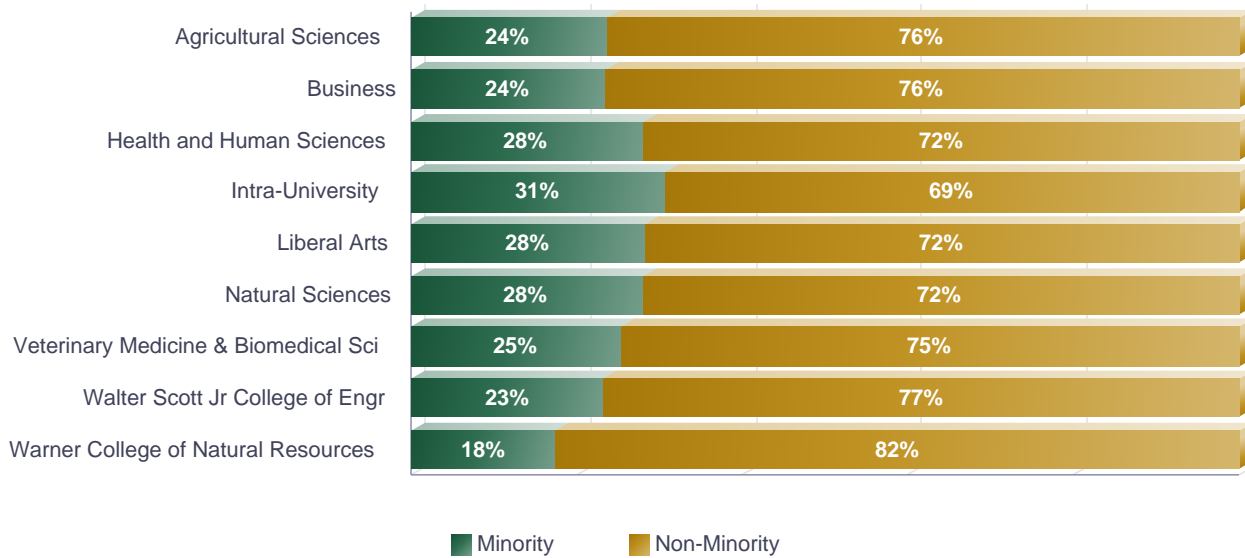

Fall 2021 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Minority Status - Percent of Students

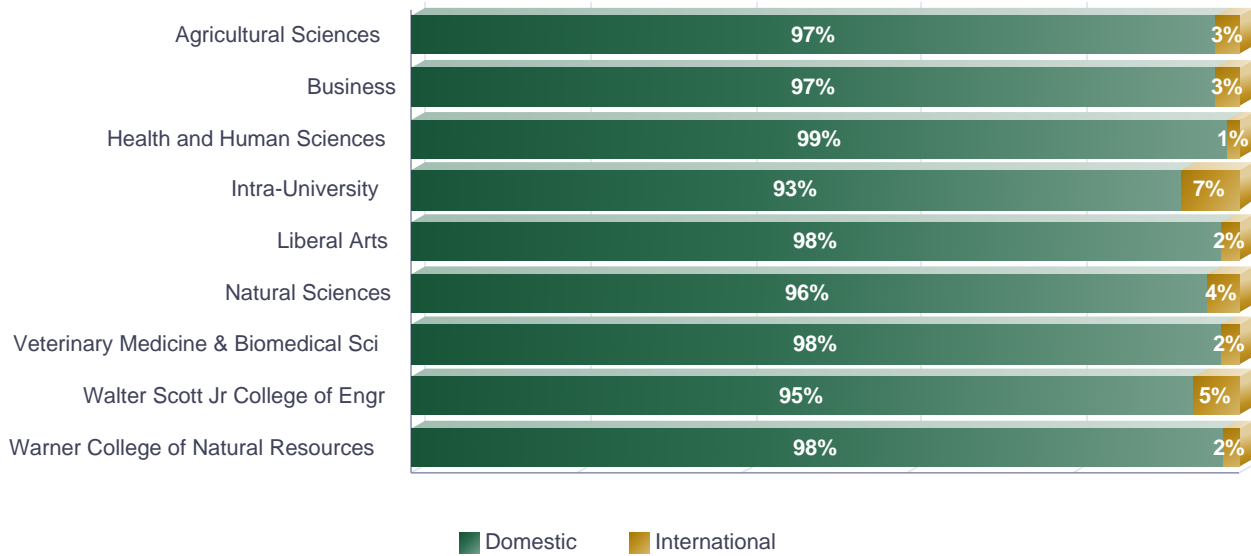

**Fall 2021 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and International Status - Percent of Students**



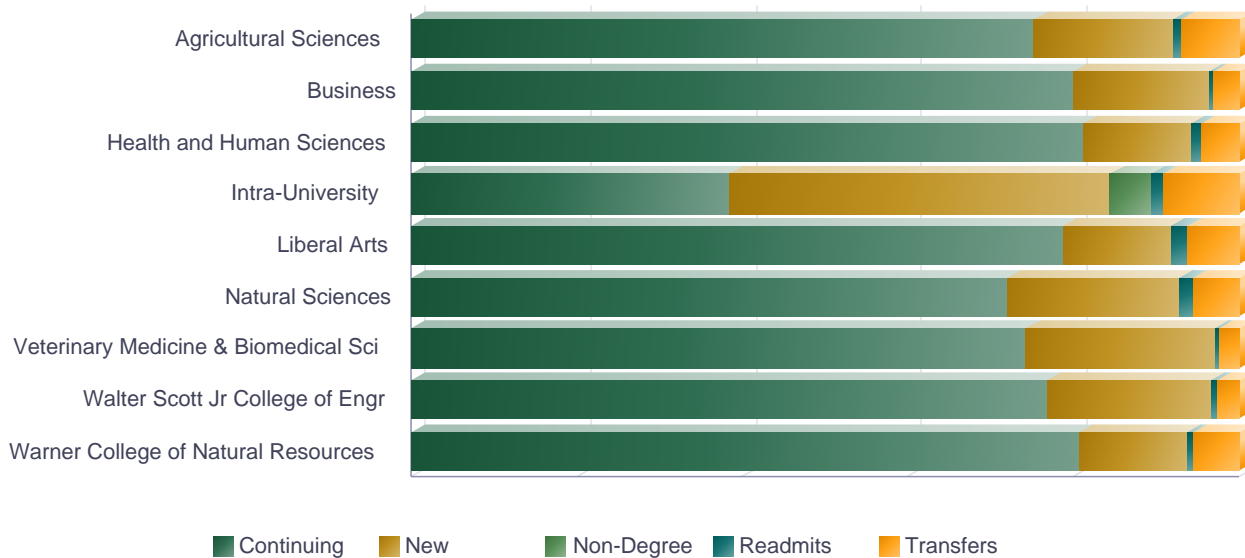

Fall 2021 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Registration Type - Percent of Students

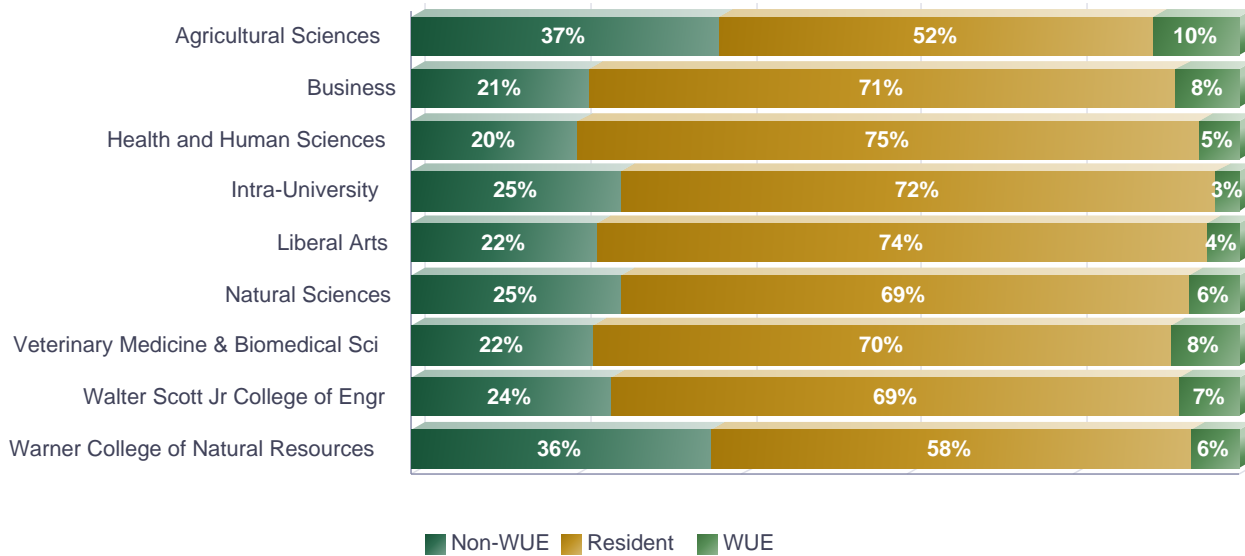

Fall 2021 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Residency - Percent of Students

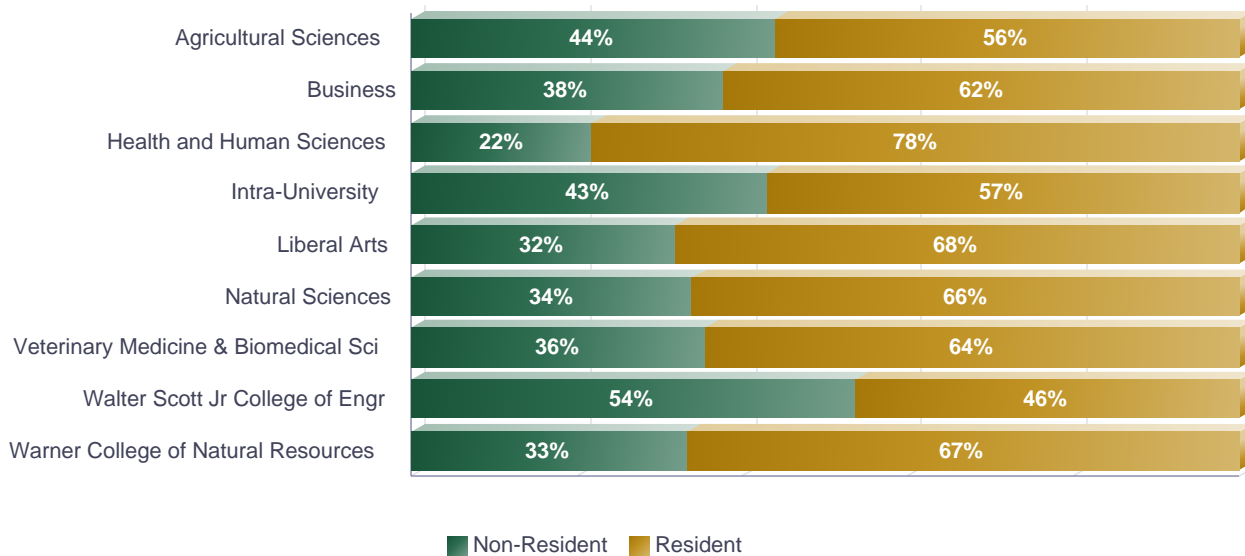

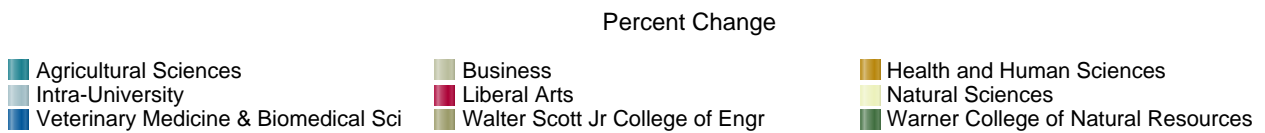
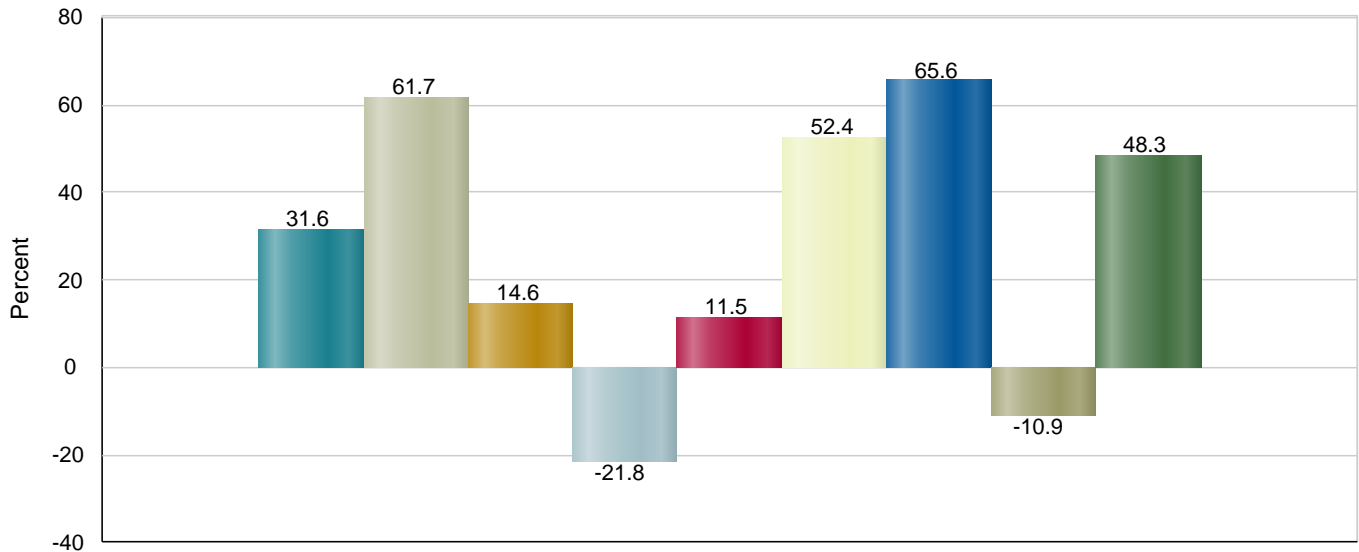
**Fall 2021 CCHE Index Distribution**

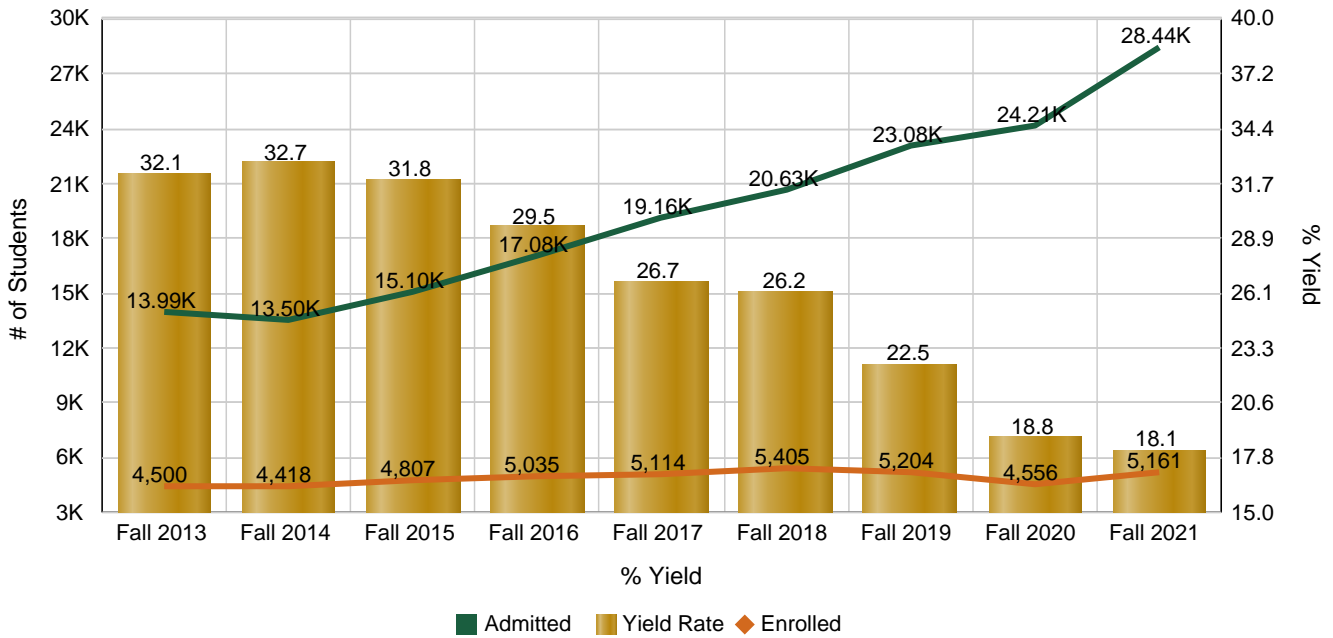

**Fall 2013 to Fall 2021 Percent Change in New Freshman by Application College**



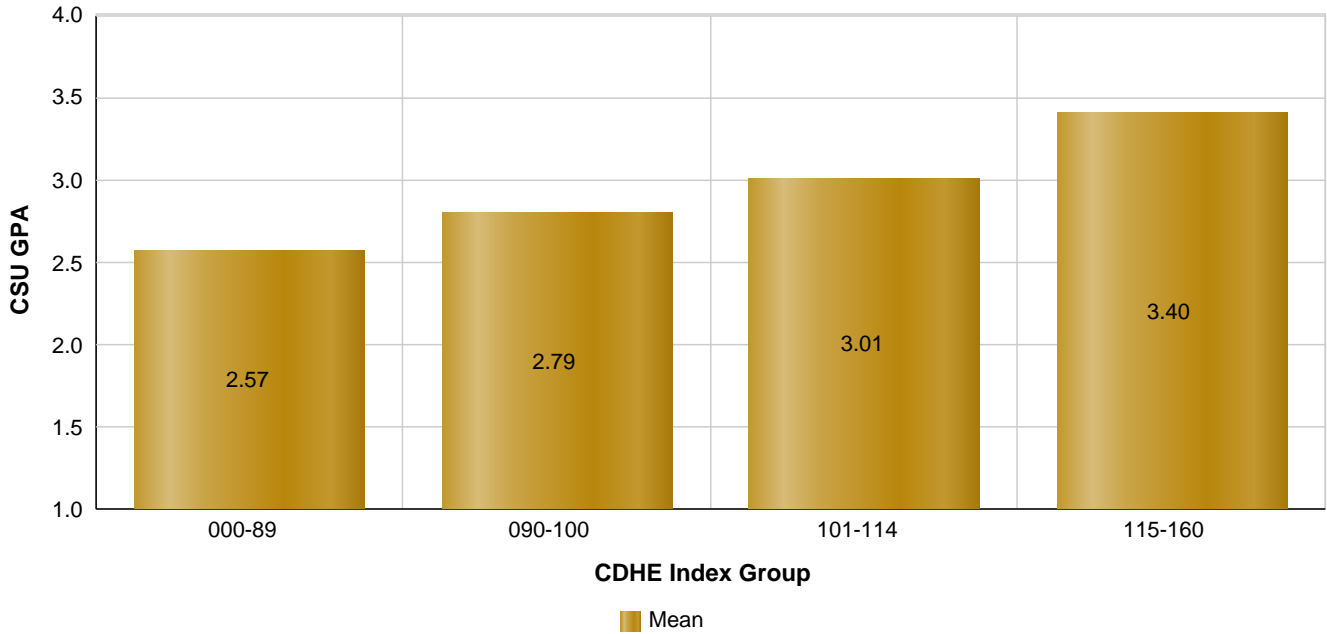

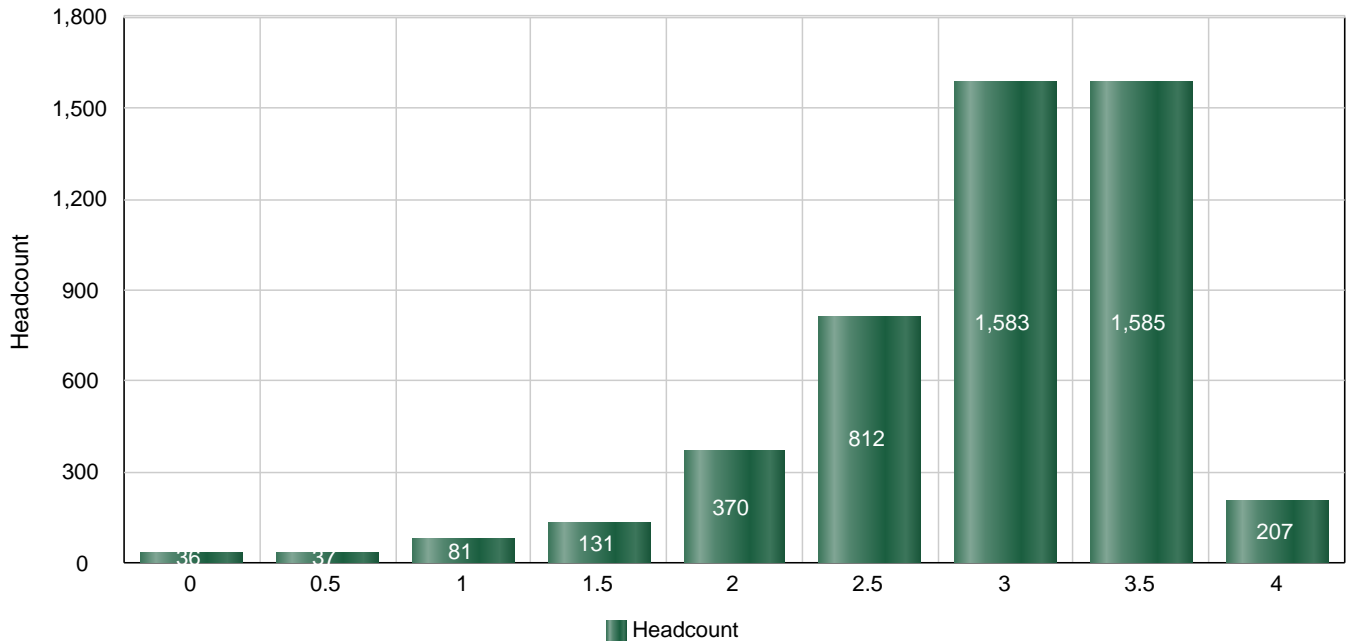


Fall Term New Freshman First-Year CSU Grade Point Average - Fall 2020 Entering Freshmen

First-Year CSU GPA Distribution - Number of Students

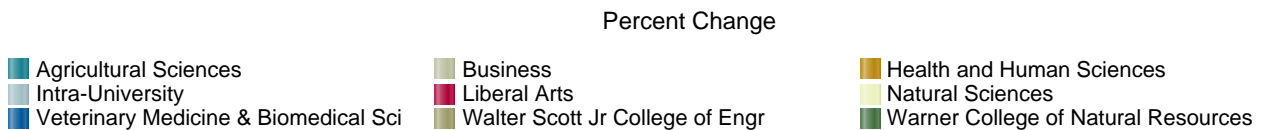
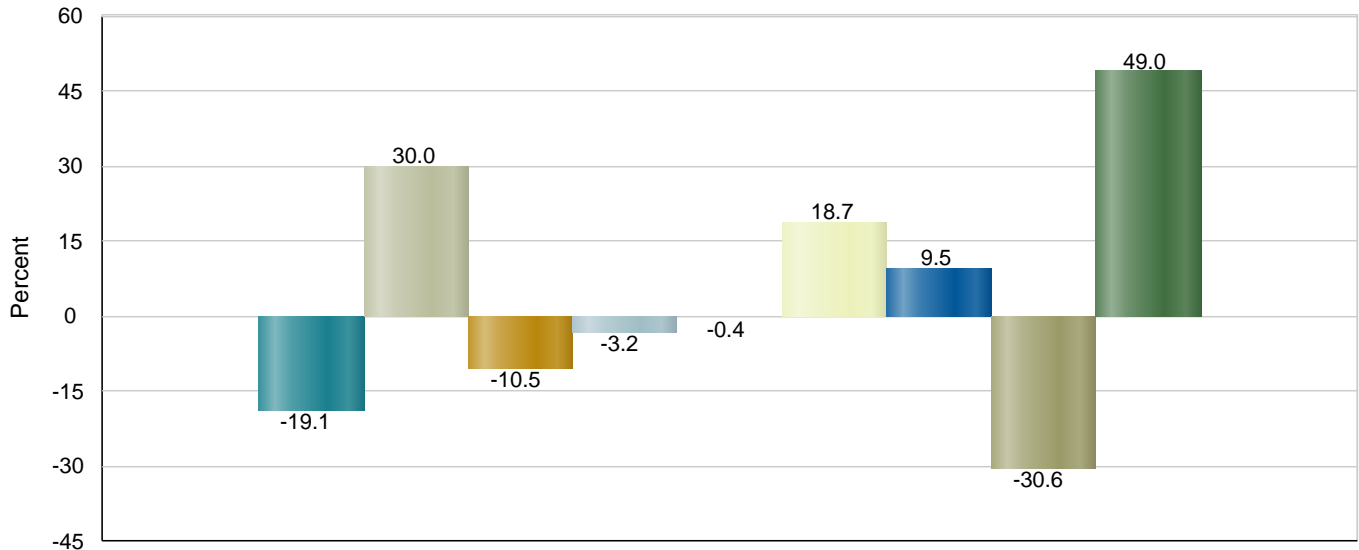

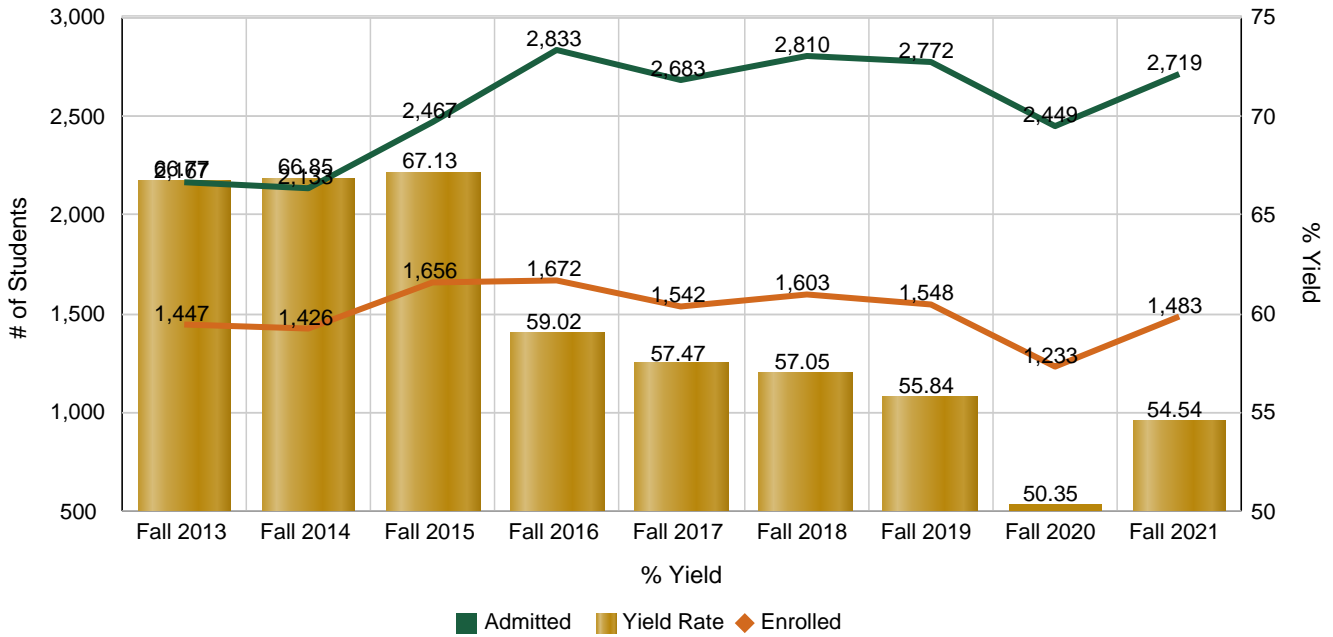

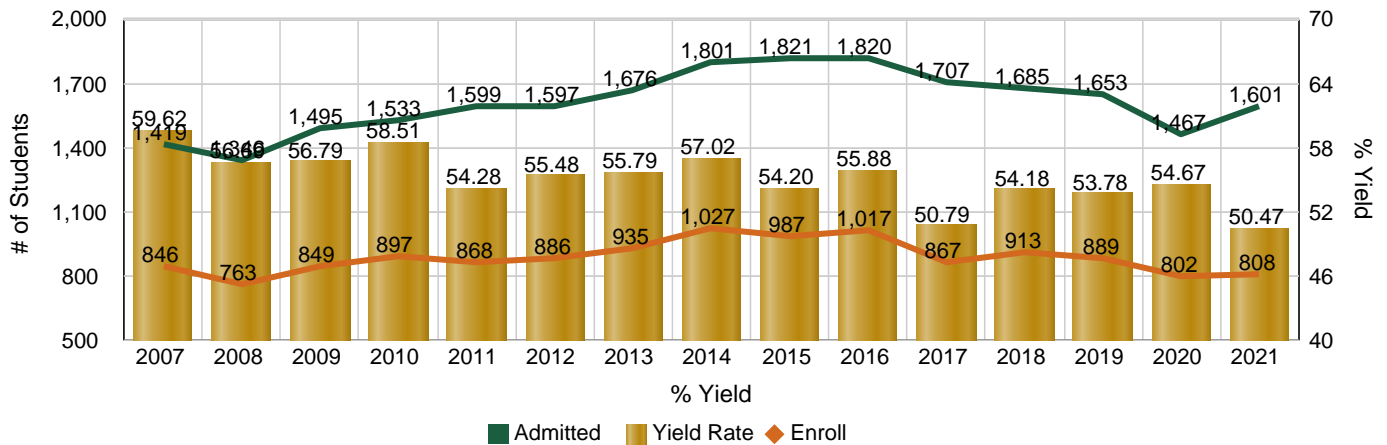

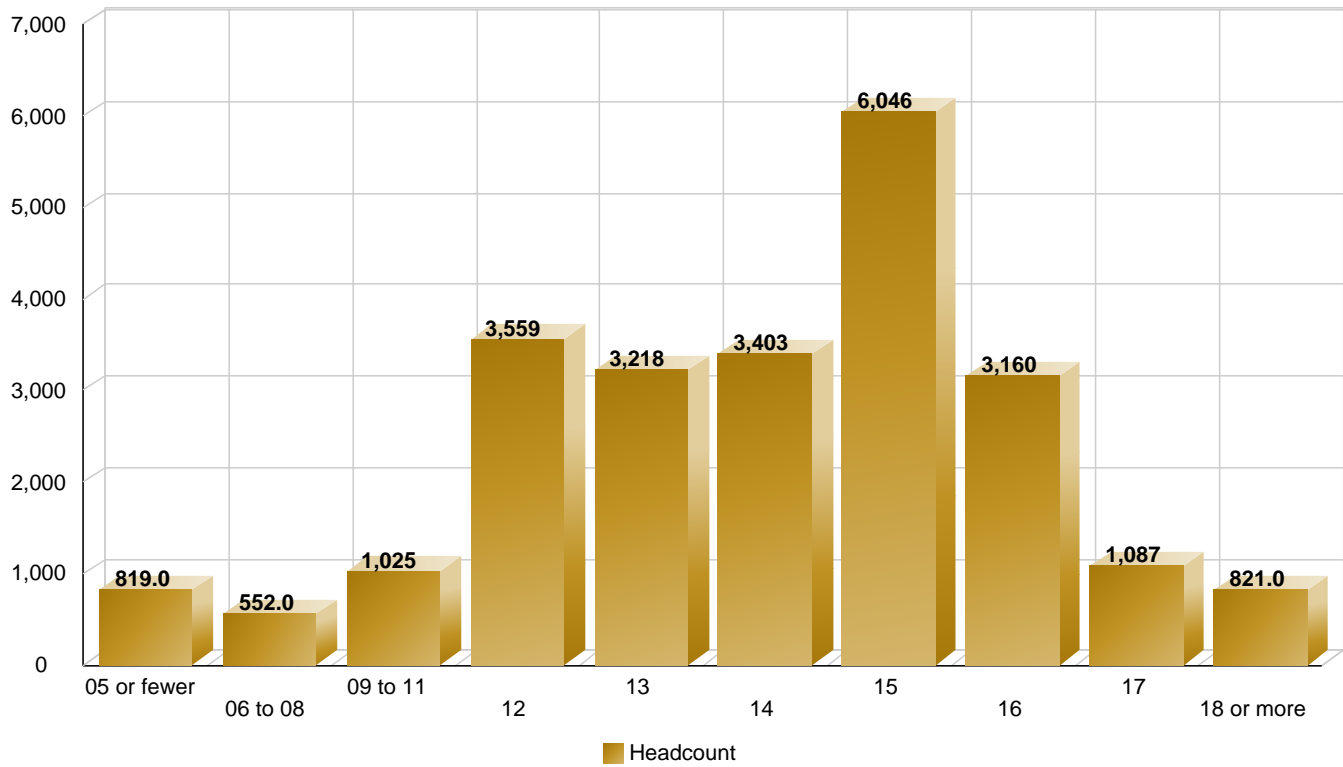

Fall 2021 Undergraduate Students by Credit Load

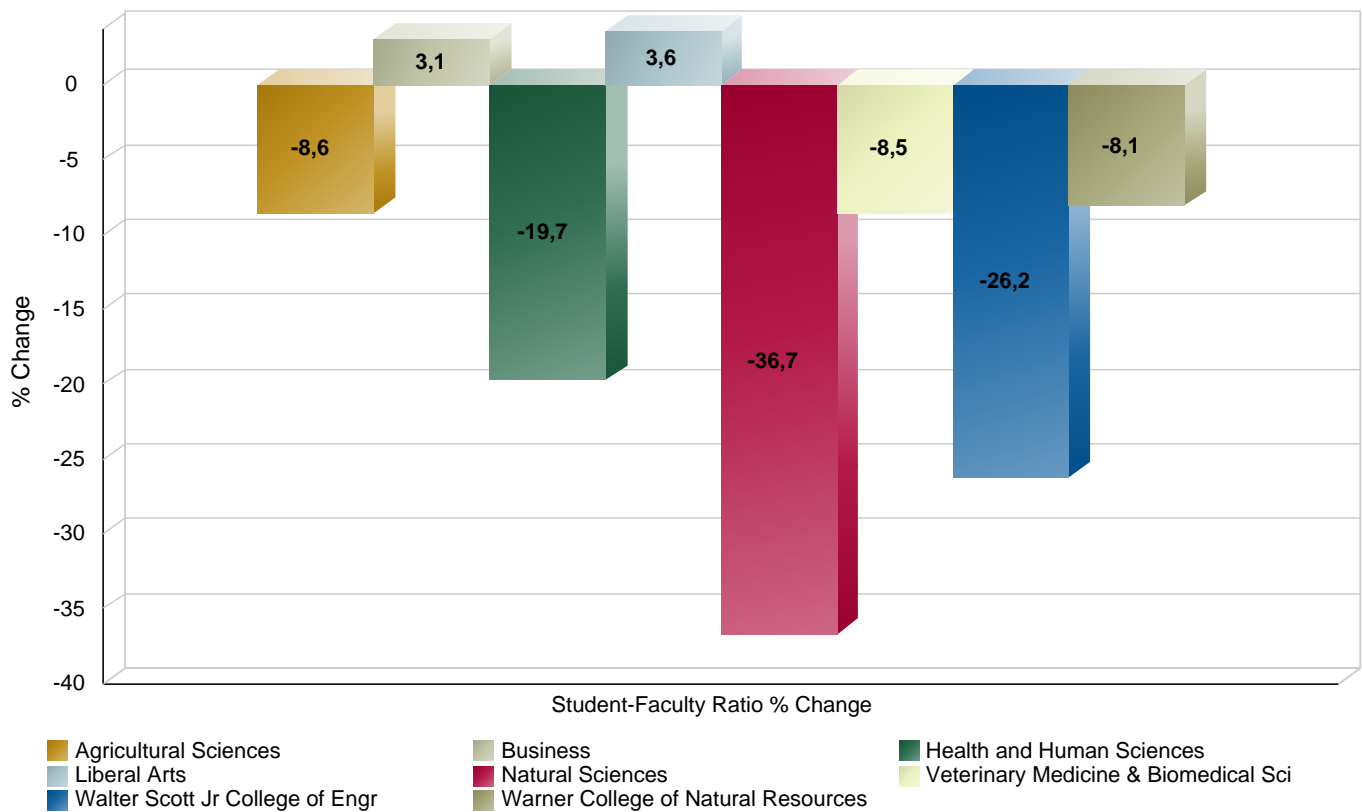

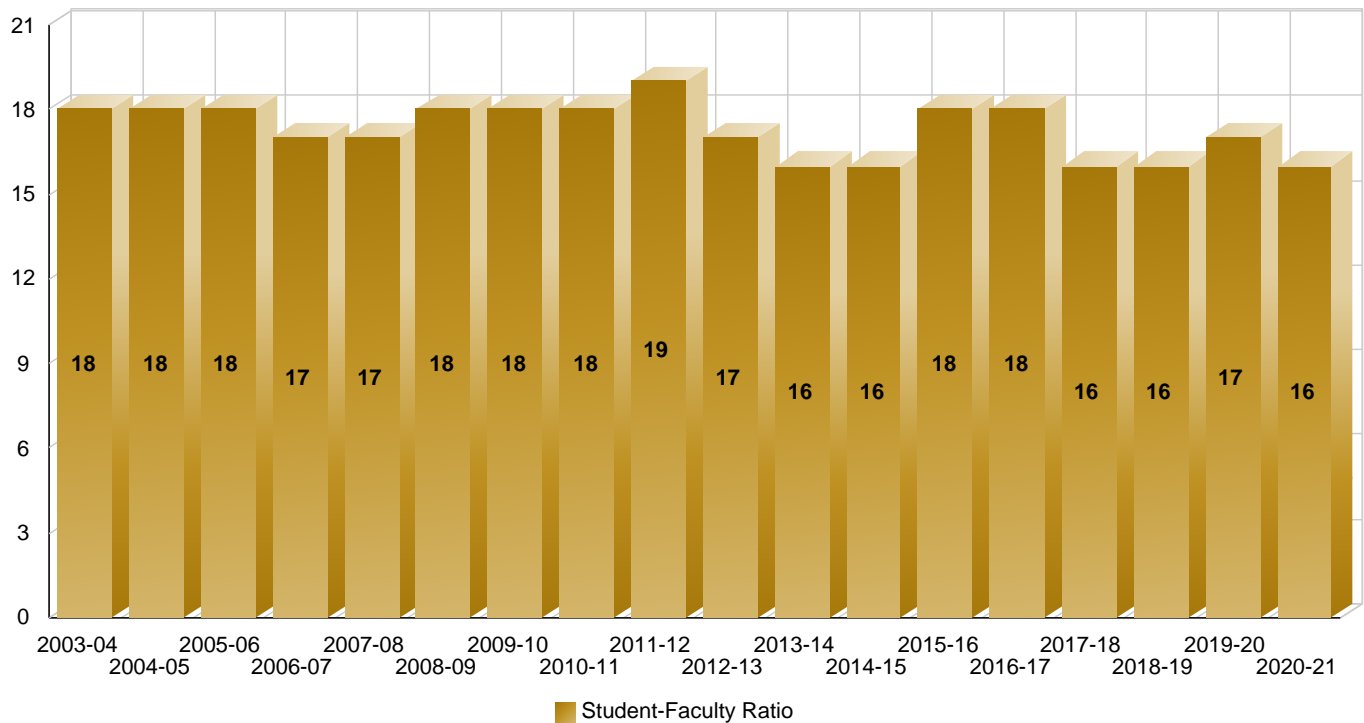

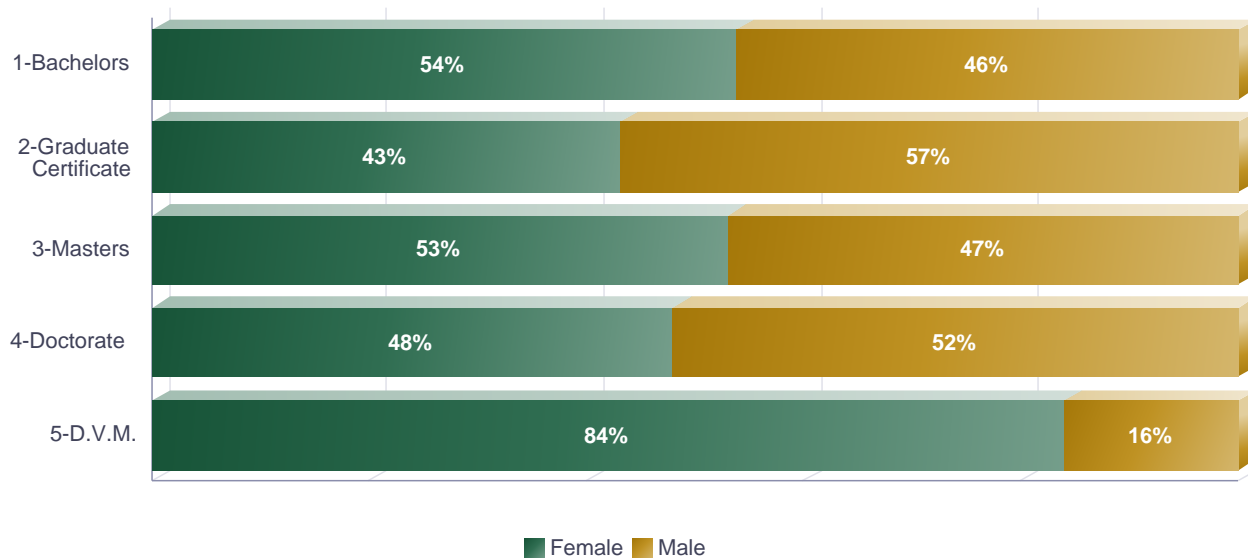
Degrees Awarded by Degree Category and STEM Status - Percent of Students

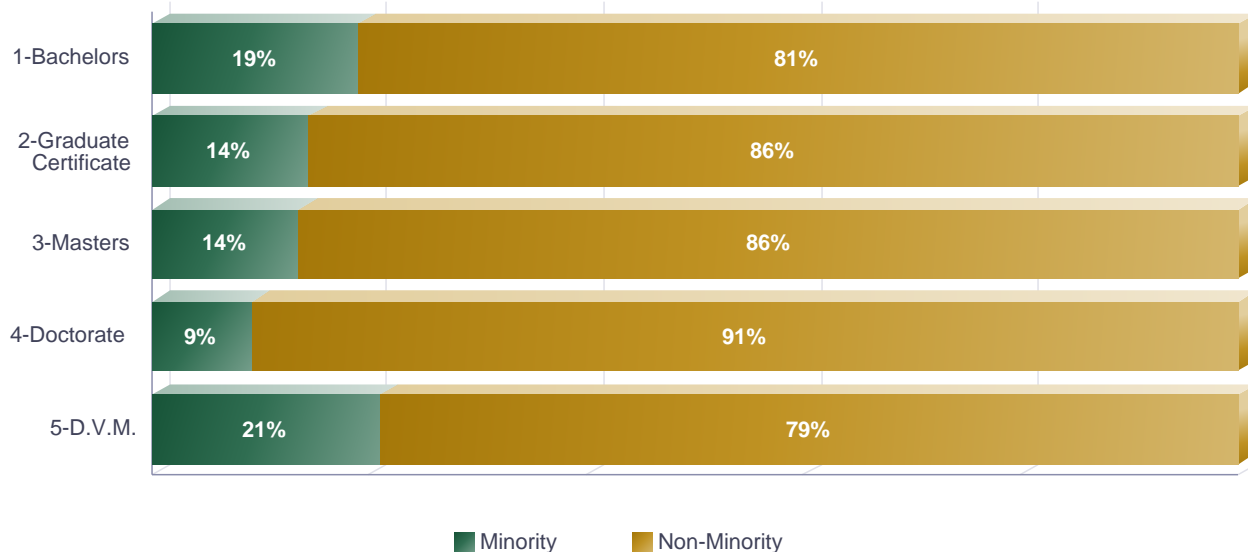
Degrees Awarded by Degree Category and Gender - Percent of Students

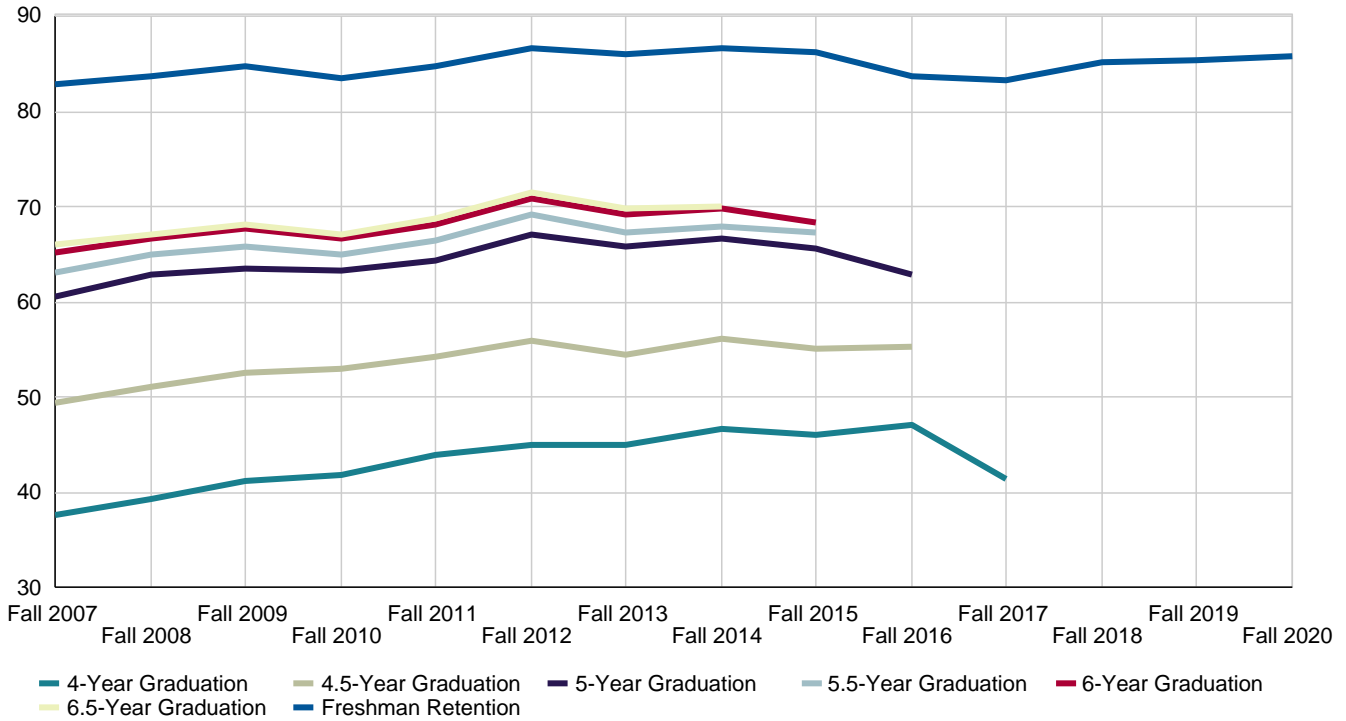

Degrees Awarded by Degree Category and Minority Status - Percent of Students

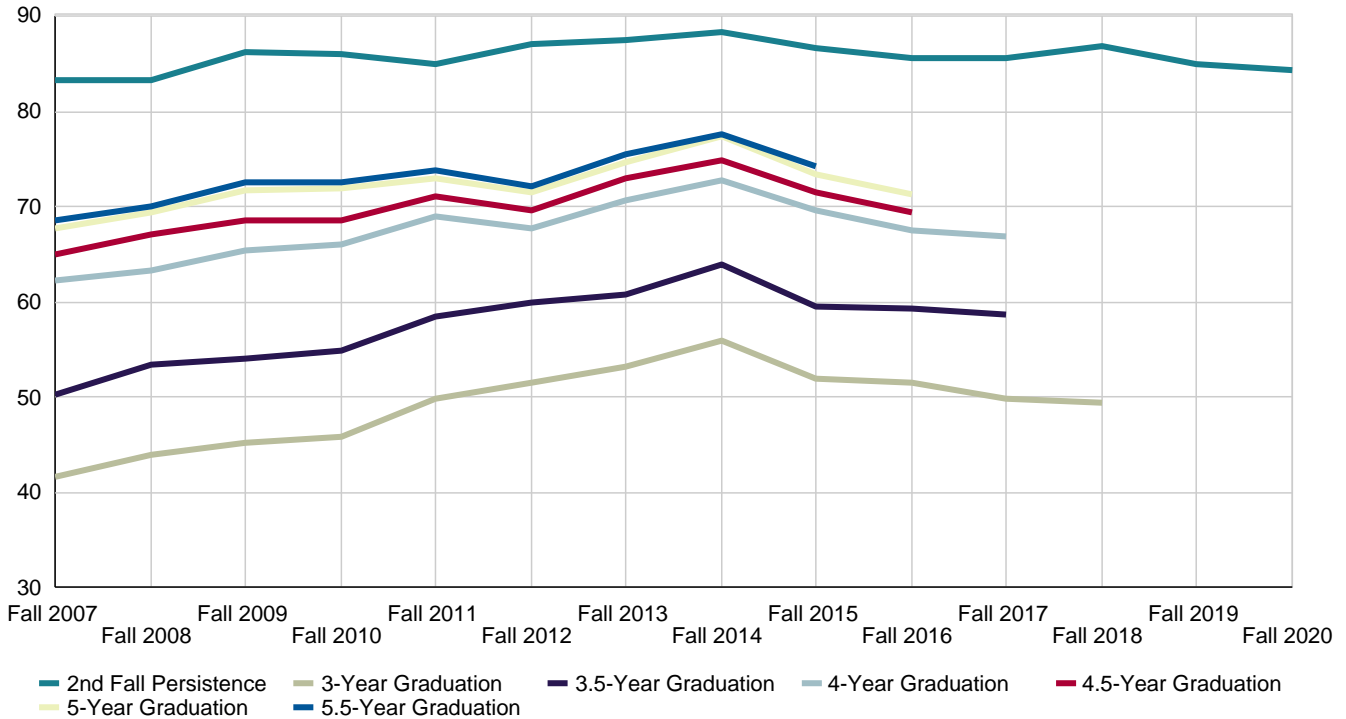

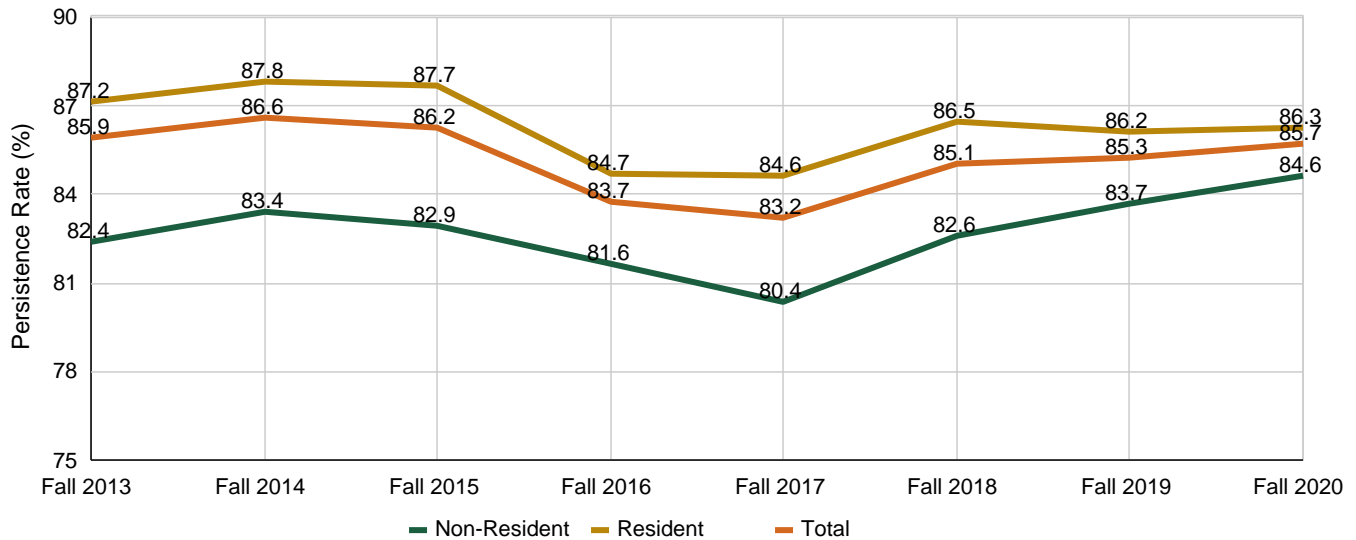
**History of Transfer Students 2nd-Fall Persistence and Graduation Rates**

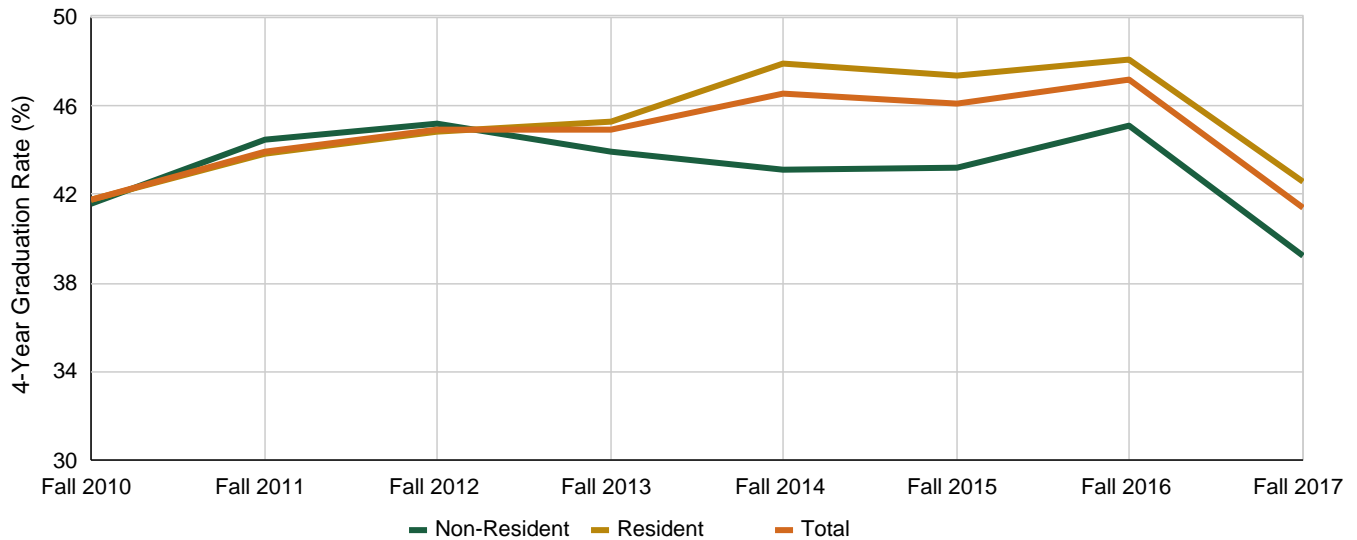

**New Freshman 4-Year Graduation by Residency - Comparison with Total**

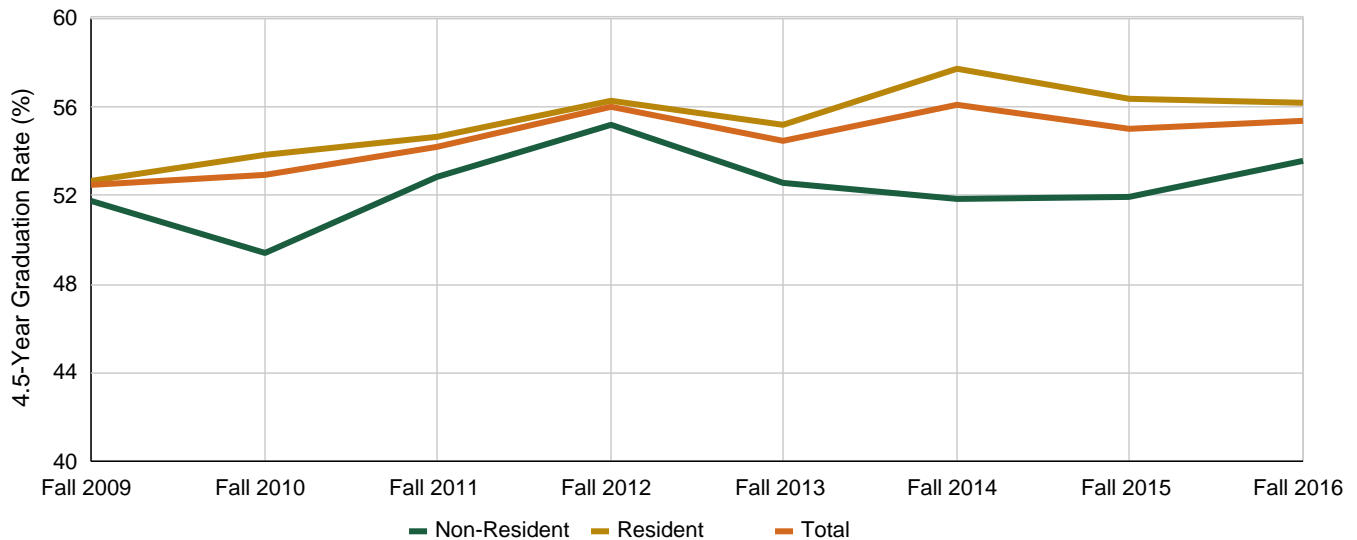

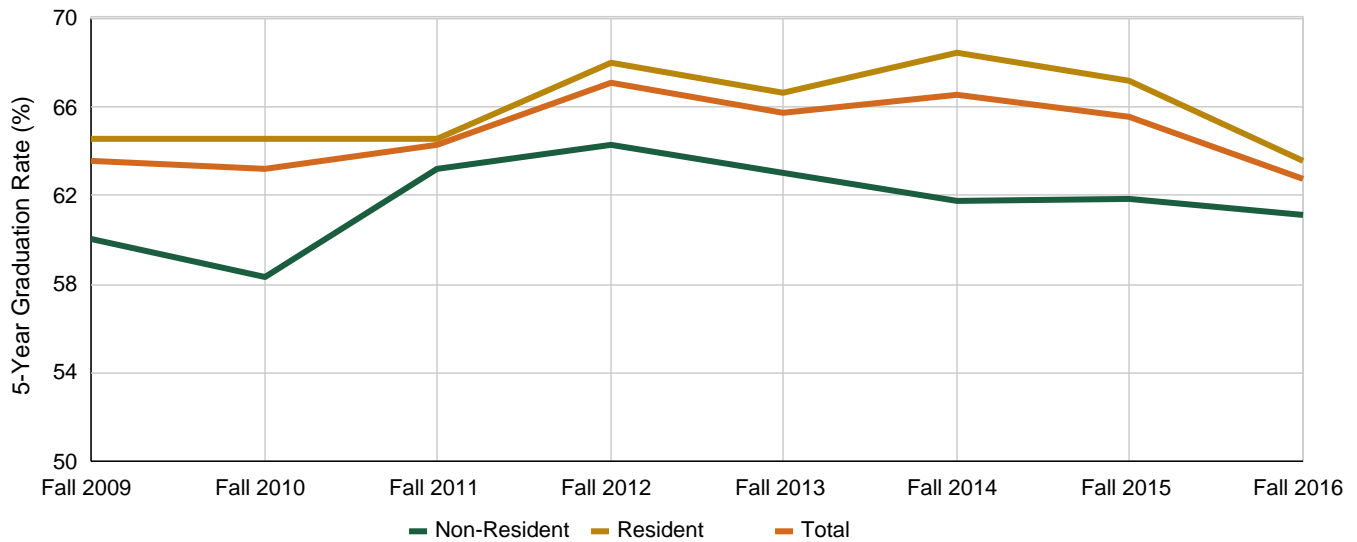

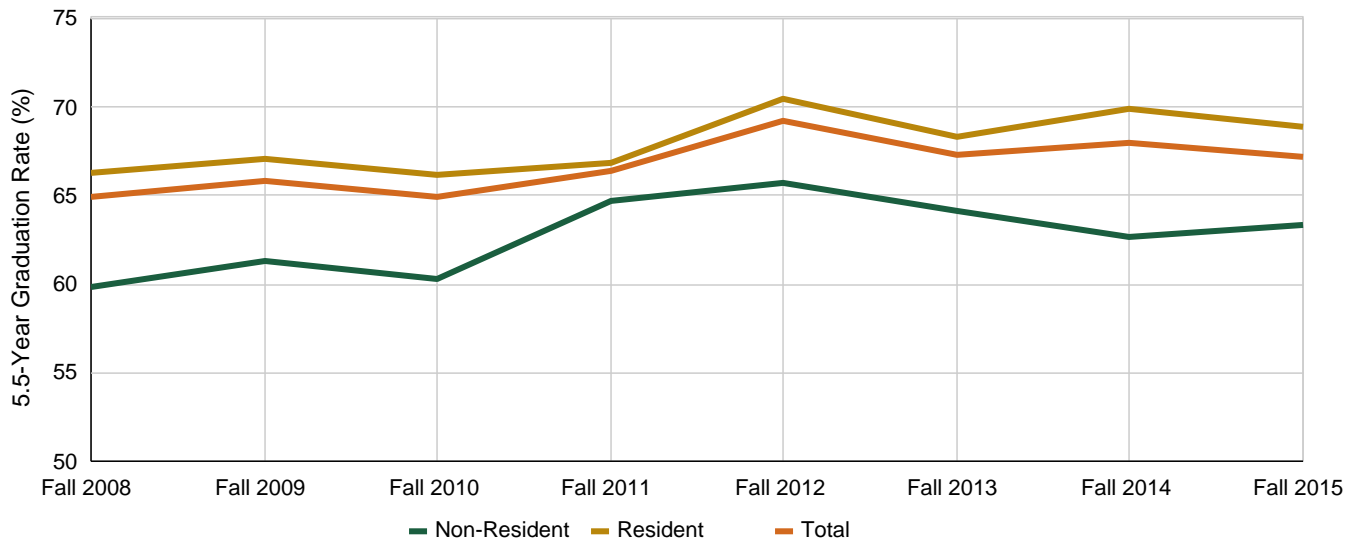

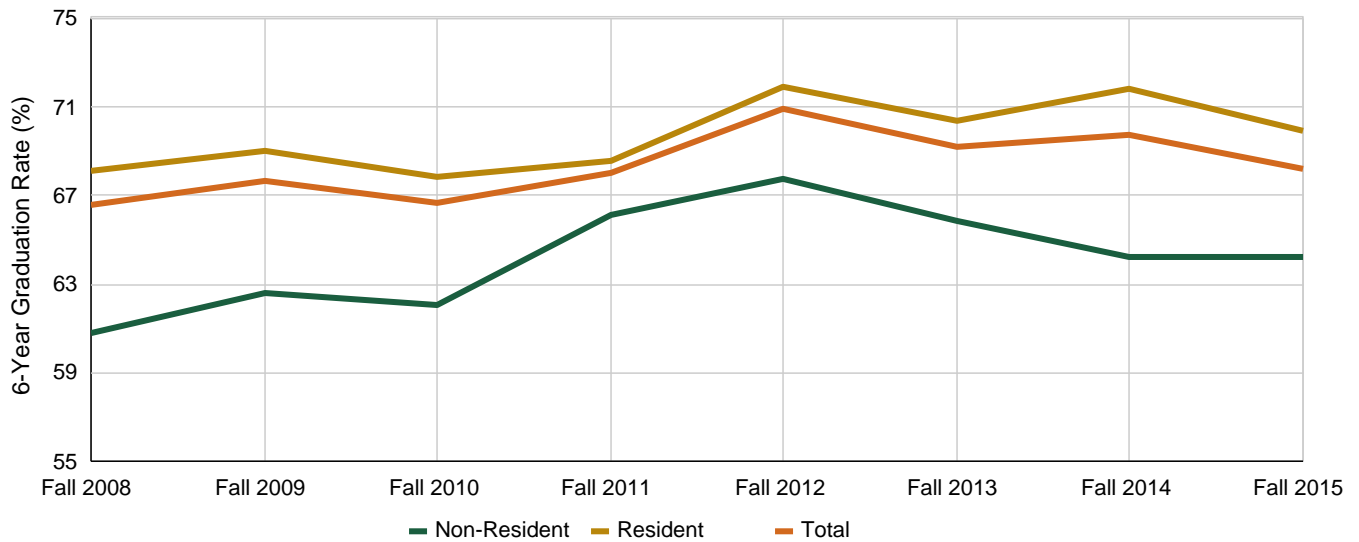

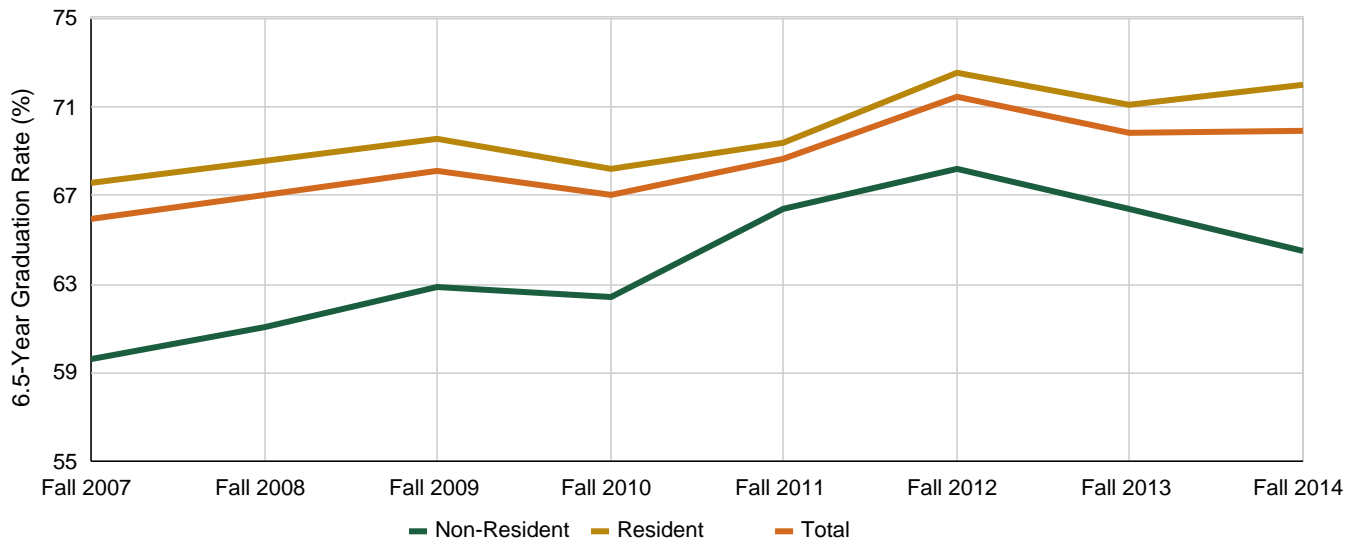

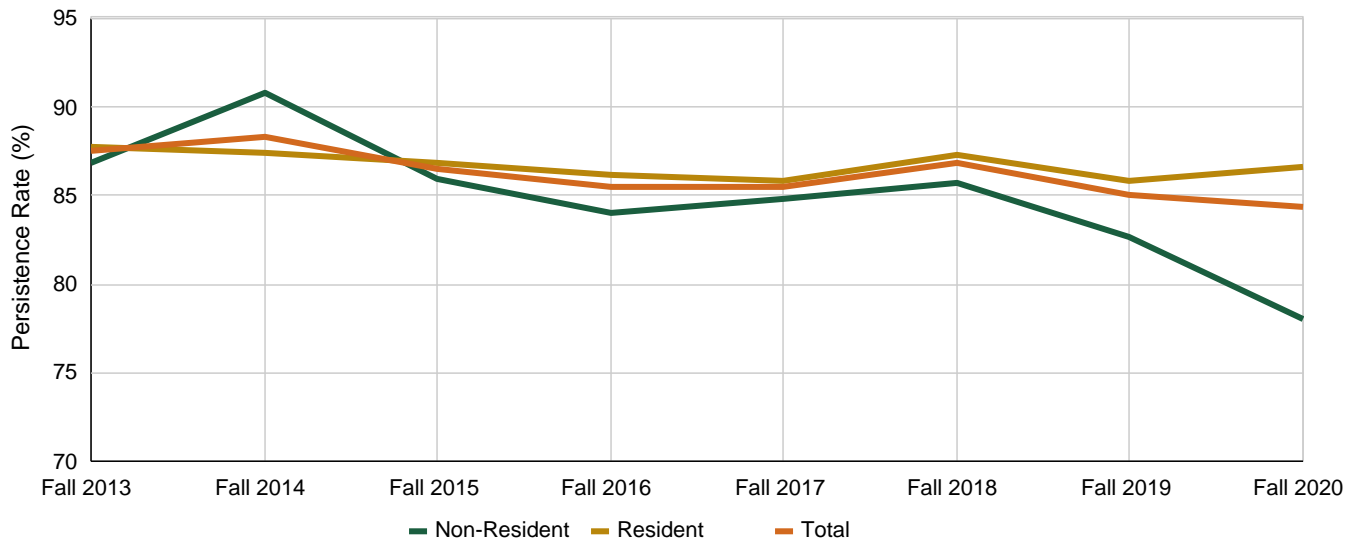
**New Freshman 6.5-Year Graduation by Residency - Comparison with Total**

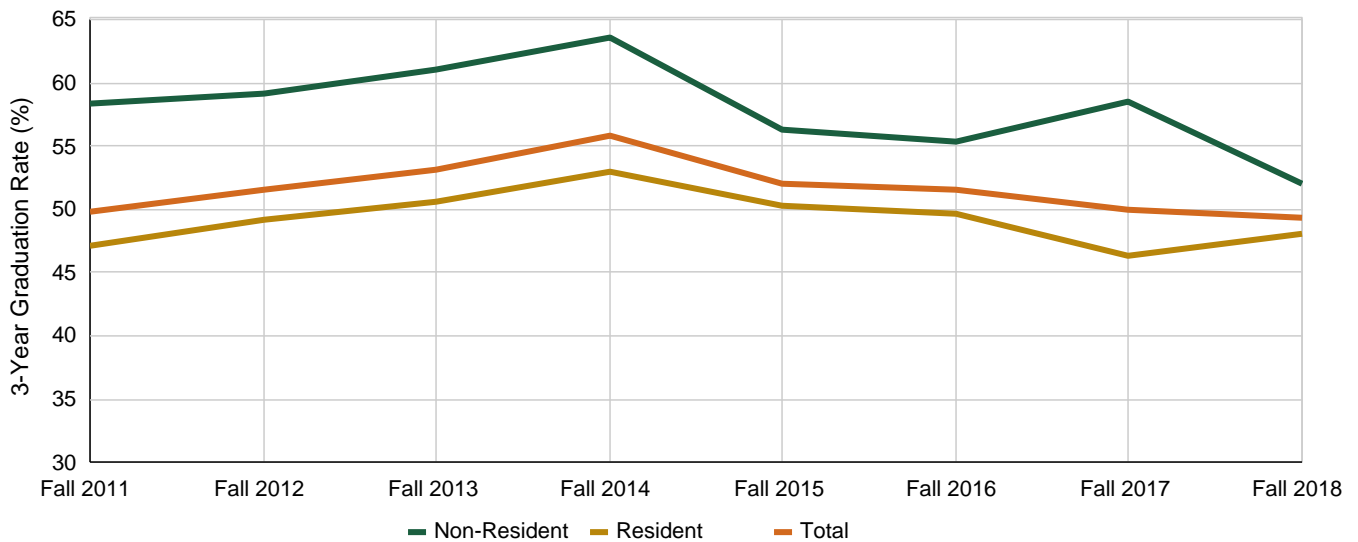
**Transfer 2nd-Fall Persistent by Residency - Comparison with Total**

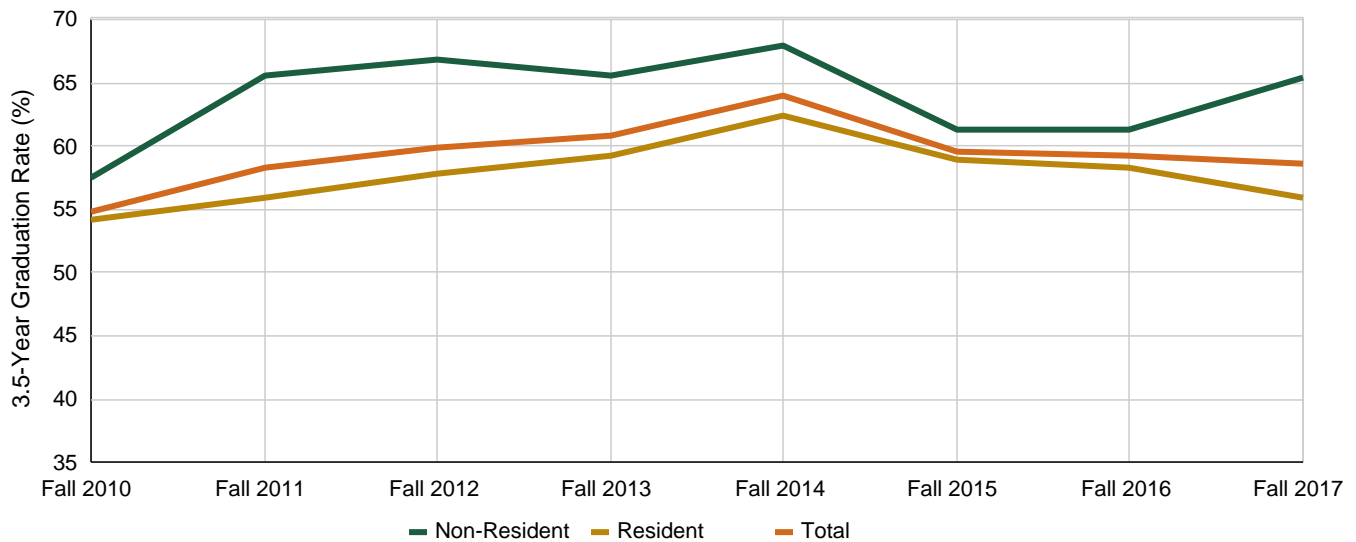

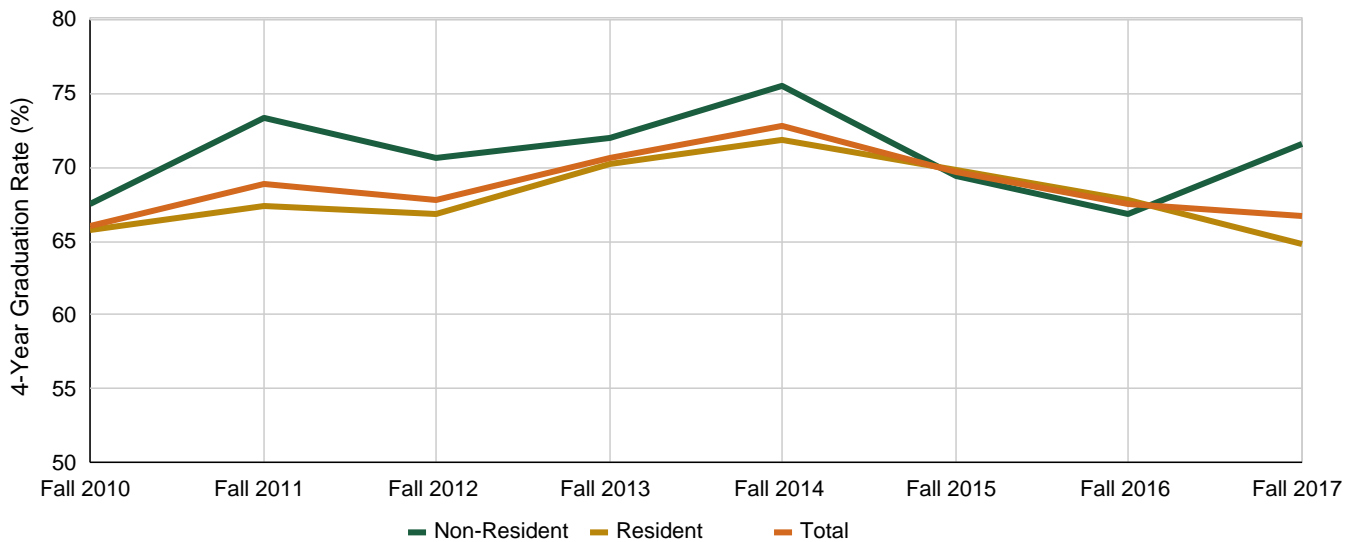

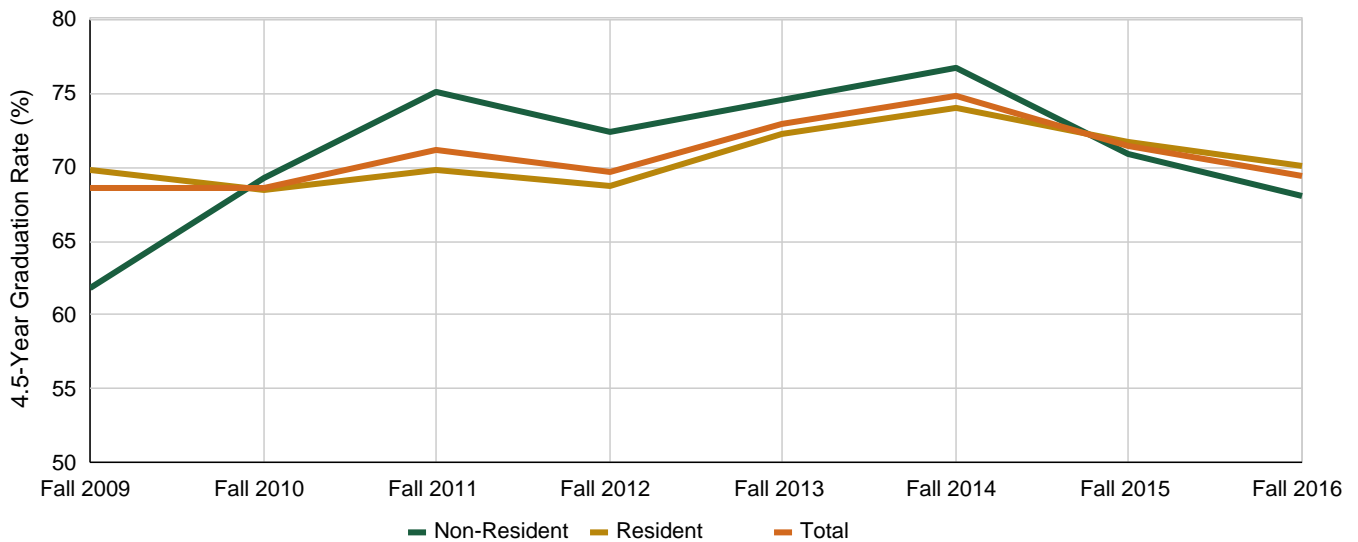
